

GREAT OAKS MIXED USE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

San Jose, CA



DGC was the general contractor selected to manage and construct this project. The project was a master planned residential and commercial mixed-use site. The project entailed mass grading of the site, installation of wet and dry utilities, construction of new concrete hardscape, construction of new onsite streets, and the reconfiguration of off-site streets. DGC was tasked with bidding out the various subcontract work trades, acquiring bids from the various subcontractors, reviewing the bids with owner and selecting the most responsive and responsible subcontractors. DGC's scope of work on the project involved moving 260,000 cubic yards of soil onsite, placement of 18,000 tons of aggregate base, placement of 7,000 tons of asphalt concrete.
